The General Assembly of the European Union of Rechtspfleger has adopted the following

R e s o l u t i o n :

1. The European Union of Rechtspfleger welcomes the initiative by the Romanian Ministry of Justice to propose to the Romanian Government a bill for the creation of the professions of Rechtspfleger and Court Manager, based on the Green Paper for a European Rechtspfleger (available at: www.eu-rechtspfleger.eu).
2. The European Union of Rechtspfleger invites all European nations to introduce an adapted European Rechtspfleger into their legal systems, in the spirit of both the Green Paper and the recommendations of the European Commission for the Efficiency of Justice (CEPEJ).
3. The European Union of Rechtspfleger supports the continuing efforts of the European Union at harmonizing laws in a common European legal space and calls for the creation of a European Certificate of Inheritance, a European Trade Register and a European Land Registry.
4. The European Union of Rechtspfleger calls for procedures in non-contentious matters to be drafted with a view to efficiency and proximity with the people.
5. In order to guarantee that European citizens enjoy a fast and quality delivery of justice in a harmonized legal space and to avoid overload and backlog, it is necessary to :
 - provide courts with sufficient staff
 - create good working conditions
 - transfer tasks according to competence
 - pay appropriate wages
